AERU is a non-profit research trust and volunteer programme focusing on behaviour, welfare and management of African elephants in captive environments. AERU's primary mission is to improve the welfare of captive African elephants by conducting non-invasive research (at KEP and beyond) and publishing the findings in peer-reviewed journals. This internship represents a rare opportunity to be part of a research team on a semi-captive population of habituated elephants in a naturalistic environment where 24/7 behavioural observation is possible. You will gain valuable experience in the field of animal behaviour and zoology whilst also developing AERU into a globally respected voice for captive elephant welfare.
