The successful mentee will be given the opportunity to gain experience in the main aspects of animal breeding in South Africa with a focus on research, development and application of genetic merit prediction, genetic selection, and other uses of recorded data from farm and other animals.

The mentorship program spans a period of six months.

Requirements are as follows:

- *MSc degree or higher in animal breeding and/or genetics.
- Proven record of working with large datasets and in the use of the R statistical package.
- Proven record of statistical analyses, including correlation, regression and anova analyses and interpretation.
- Working knowledge and application of model specification, genetic parameter estimation and breeding value prediction using available computer programs.
- Valid driver's license.

Highly recommended:

- Working knowledge and use of computer packages in the analyses of SNP-based genomic data.
- Working knowledge of Linux operating system.
- Working knowledge of SQL and open-source database software.
- Programming skills in report generation.

The successful candidate will be stationed in Bloemfontein and will receive a monthly remuneration for the duration of the program.
