FROM THE OFFICE OF THE FINANCE MANAGER

Please be reminded in accordance with the Natural Scientific Professions Act 27 of 2003;

- SACNASP is a regulatory body for natural science;
- Registration with SACNAP is a legal requirement if you work in the natural sciences;
- It is an offence to practice in natural science without being registered with SACNASP;
- Scientists with long overdue fees may be cancelled and will be required to pay a re-instatement fee in order to be reregistered; and
- Scientists remain liable for any fee, arrears or penalty imposed by the Council for the period that he or she was registered.

SACNASP therefore requests all Registered Scientists to ensure all outstanding fees are settled urgently via our new online scientist portal using the following link <u>https://portal.sacnasp.org.za/login</u>. Your password will be your ID / Passport number (unless already amended by you). Once logged in, your outstanding balance will be displayed. Click on "Manage account", Choose amount to pay available in instalments of 25%, Click on "Continue", then click on "Proceed to Payfast" in order to settle your outstanding balance. Following online payment via Payfast in full, you will be able to download a registration certificate.
